** The Clayton Community Library Foundation is seeking participants for its 6th annual **Creekside Arts Celebration!** as the library celebrates its 14th anniversary with the theme, "Cultural Legacies...reflections of our past". Join us as we explore our ethnic and cultural diversity through the arts. This FREE public fundraising benefit supports environmental education programs in the library's certified wildlife habitat. Highlighted will be both interactive visual and performing arts and entertainment for all ages, including art sales, storytelling, slam poetry, a celebrity guest author, environmental education groups and community participation. Last year's highly successful addition of juried artwork submissions will be repeated this year with awards given to artists who creatively interpret this year's cultural theme. Members from the local artists group, Creekside Artists Guild, will be amongst the artists selling and demonstrating their art forms. This event provides a great opportunity to raise public awareness about biodiversity while showcasing our own library creekside certified wildlife habitat. See how science inspires art in "BioArt" works of art. The ever popular outdoor interpretive tour will return with photo opportunities led by renowned, local wildlife biologist, Jim Hale.

This year's event will be held on Friday evening, March 6th (6:00-8:30pm), Saturday, March 7th (10am-6pm) and Sunday, March 8th (1-5pm). Friday evening will include an artists "mini-showcase" and sampling of art for sale, along with awards for juried artwork submitted within the "cultural & ethnic" theme, a "live" raptor, music and refreshments. Saturday & Sunday, more art sales continue with live demo's., environmental groups & nature tours, poetry and ethnic performances by the local community including Clayton Valley High Schools Clayton Arts Academy. The weekend celebration will be held throughout the inside of the library, Story and Community rooms, adjoining outdoor courtyard and interpretive area in the certified wildlife habitat.

Artists are requested to donate \$30 for space to sell their work as well as a small percentage (20%) of their profits toward this fundraiser to benefit the environmental education programs in the library wildlife habitat and related library materials.
